Health Insurance

Students will have to register on <u>https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr</u> at their arrival at school so as to be covered by the mandatory French social insurance that covers a part of medical expenses



while studying in France. Students can also take and pay a complementary private insurance to get additional reimbursements.

For European Union students, before coming to France, they will have to get their European health insurance card (or temporary certificate) with relevant state institutions of their country.
